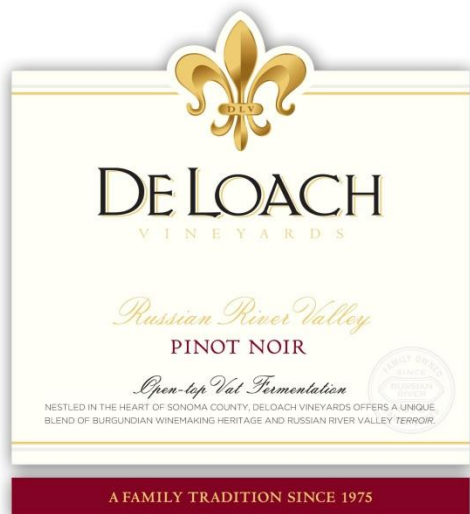

RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY PINOT NOIR

In the Vineyard

The cool, foggy Russian River Valley climate allows for slow ripening, enabling grapes to develop full flavor maturation over an extended time. To create our 2010 Russian River Valley Pinot Noir, grapes were hand-harvested from our vineyards.

Conversations with the Winemaker

Crafted using traditional Burgundian techniques, including fermentation in small tanks, hand punch-downs and aging in 60-gallon French and Hungarian oak barrels, this Pinot Noir is an elegant example of the varietal. The wine was aged in 100% French and Hungarian oak for 10 months.

Tasting Notes

Opening with enticing red berry fruit, the aromas of our 2010 Russian River Valley Pinot Noir seamlessly blend with hints of Bing cherry and forest floor. Delicate notes of anise and cola accent the fruit and a rich palate of black cherry and strawberry is supported by medium fine-grained tannins. The finish lingers with subtle, toasty undertones and excellent balance.
